




The campus of Illinois State University covers 711 acres and includes 55 major buildings, most built within the past two decades. Recreational facilities include an 18-hole golfcourse, a 310 acre University Farm, Bowling and Billiards Center, and Horton Fieldhouse and Hancock Stadium.








Cook Hall, also known as "the castle" houses the University radio station, WGLT, and a gymnasium.



Most of the business classes are held in Stevenson Hall, named after Adlai E. Stevenson  $\blacksquare$ .



The Union includes six conference rooms with seating capacity of over 1800, plus the three-level Union Auditorium. The Union Auditorium has a seating capacity of 3500, and recent entertainment events have included Bill Cosby, Jane Fonda, and <u>A Chorus Line</u>.



Watterson Towers, the largest dormitory in the United States, rises 28 stories above the University. Each tower houses over 1100 students.



Williams Hall, formerly Milner Library, is in the process of being renovated in order to house the College of Business.

### History of Illinois State University

Illinois State University was founded on August 22, 1857 in Normal, Illinois. It was the first public institution of higher education in the state. President Abraham Lincoln drafter the documents which established Illinois State Normal University. It was originally a teacher's college.

The first principal of Illinois State Normal University was Charles Hovey. He was a member of the State Board of Education and had shown an interest in ISNU from its conception as he was on the Committee on Location for the university. The State Board of Education held a vote for the selection of the first principal, and Charles Hovey was elected unanimously. Hovey was a graduate of Dartmouth College and had been a teacher and principal prior to his election to be principal of ISNU.

Among the first faculty members at Illinois State Normal University were Ira Moore and Mary Brooks. Ira Moore was from Chicago and was a graduate of Bridgewater Normal. He was an instructor in the normal department at ISNU. Mary Brooks was from Peoria and headed the Model School.

The first classes were held in Major's Hall in Bloomington, Illinois as the buildings of the university had not been completed at the time classes began. The first classes at Illinois State Normal University began on October 5, 1857.

After more than a century as a single-purpose teacher education institution, the 1960's brought several significant changes for the university including the expansion of purpose to offer liberal arts as well as teacher education programs. In 1964, the name of the university was changed from Illinois State Normal University to Illinois State University.

Graduate work at the master's degree level was introduced in 1943. Doctoral-level programs were introduced in 1963. Currently, Illinois State University offers a comprehensive range of undergraduate programs in 59 major fields of study, a wide range of master's degree programs in 32 fields, and doctoral programs in the eight fields of Art, Biological Sciences, Curriculum and Instruction, Economics, Educational Administration, English, History, and Mathematics.

### Enrollment

Illinois State University currently enrolls 19,717 students. Of these, 4,728 students (almost  $\frac{1}{4}$  of the total enrollment population) are declared majors in business. Illinois State employs about 1,300 faculty members.

### Accreditation

Illinois State University is fully accredited by the Commission on Institutions of Higher Education of the North Central Association Commission on Institutions of Higher Education and by the National Council for Accreditation of Teacher Education. It is also accredited by the National Association of Schools of Art, the American Speech and Hearing Association in Audiology, the American Medical Association in Medical Records Administration, the National Association of Schools of Music, and the American Speech and Hearing Association in Speech Pathology. 

### HISTORY OF THE COLLEGE OF BUSINESS

After more than one hundred years as one of the leading normal schools in the nation, ISU emerged in the 1960's as a broad-based university offering a wide variety of academic program through 30 academic departments and five colleges. The College of Business at Illinois State University was formed in 1967. And, at this time more than one out of every five declared majors is housed in the College of Business. (This proportion is expected to increase greatly.)

There are ten basic objectives within the College of Business. 1) To prepare undergraduate students for careers utilizing the discipline of accounting in business, government, industry, and public accounting firms; 2) To prepare undergraduate students to teach business and business-related courses in the secondary school system and the community colleges; 3) To prepare undergraduate students for meaningful and fulfilling careers in business and office administration as such knowledge is required in business, government and industry; 4) To provide all students in the College of Business with opportunities to pursue a graduate degree in any one of the primary undergraduate disciplines in the college; 5) To provide undergraduate students with opportunities for meaningful internship experiences; 6) To provide opportunities for adult students to obtain continuing education leading toward baccalaureate and master's degrees; 7) To provide opportunities for adults to obtain meaningful learning experiences through a variety of non-credit programs tailored to the needs of general and special segments of the market in business, government, and industry; 8) To provide special instructional programs directed toward the dissemination of business knowledge to present and prospective small businessmen; 9) To provide recognition for meritorious students at the departmental and collegiate levels; 10) To provide opportunities for the personal development and professional growth of students through participation in student organizations.

Upon creation of the College of Business, Lewis R. Toll was appointed Acting Dean. The Bachelor of Science in Accounting and the Bachelor of Science in Business Administration and the Master of Science in Business Administration were instituted at this time.

1968 brought Robert V. Mitchell as the Dean of the College of Business.

In 1973, Stanley Rives became Acting Dean upon the retirement of Robert V. Mitchell. E. Frank Harrison was appointed Dean of the College of Business effective July 1, 1974. In November, Philip R. Brereton was appointed Director of Executive and Professional Development. A Small Business Management program was added at this time.

The Master of Business Administration and the Master of Sciente in Accounting were approved to supersede the Master of Science in Business Administration in 1975. In 1976, the separation of the present Department of Business Administration into a Department of Management and Marketing and a Department of Finance and Law was approved. The year 1977 brought forth the division of the Department of Business Administration into the Department of Finance and Law and the Department of Management and Marketing. And, the Coordinator of Graduate Programs Office was established. Effective July 1, 1980 Andrew T. Nappi was appointed Dean of the College of Business.

The College offers bachelor's degrees in the Departments of Accounting, Business Education and Administrative Services, Finance and Law, and Management and Marketing. Also offered, Master of Science in Accounting, Master of Business Administration, and MS, or MA in Business Education.

The College maintains a viable relationship with business, industrial, and service organizations in the surrounding area. This relationship results in a strong emphasis on non-credit programs for all types of organizations and special learning experiences tailored to the needs of small businessmen. The College also has a strong commitment to the professional development of its faculty and to community involvement and public service.

### History of Eta Delta Gamma

The history of Eta Delta Gamma dates back to the Spring semester of 1980. LaVerne A. Cox, a faculty member, asked a number of faculty members in the College of Business to select a few students that they thought would be productive members of a professional fraternity. Two meetings were held with the intent of organizing the chapter and electing an executive board. This executive board met weekly until recessing for the summer. During the summer, the executive board kept in touch, once traveling to Kenosha, Wisconsin to arrange for a professional program and another time traveling to Chicago, Illinois to meet with Executive Director Ben Wolfenberger.

During the Fall semester of 1980, Eta Delta Gamma held an informal rush twice bringing the membership to approximately 55 members, where it stands now.

Also during the semester, Eta Delta Gamma staged a car wash donating all proceeds to the United Way Fund, held an ice cream social in honor of Founder's Day, entertained a guest speaker on the aspect of Marketing; as well as held a College of Business information day that was attended by a number of companies.

During a business meeting held in the Fall semester, Eta Delta Gamma was honored by the presence of Assistant Executive Director Mike Tillar and Central Regional Director Tony Fernandez. Tony informed the chapter of the Central Regional Conference in Chicago, Illinois. Two members of the executive board attended the conference. After returning from the conference, the two members briefed the chapter on the proceedings; then proceeded to meet with each officer sharing with them information that would benefit their respective committees.

- 3. To provide for social activities of its members so that they can assume responsibility for personal participation and enjoyment
- 4. To encourage and to initiate the association of students for their mutual advancement by research and practive in the activities of the business environment
- 5. To work activily for a closer affiliation between the commercial world and the students of commerce
- 6. To further a higher standard of commercial ethics and culture and the civic and commercial welfare of the Normal-Bloomington area.

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DEAN OF COLLEGE OF BUSINESS

Dr. Andrew Nappi was named Dean of the College of Business on May 22, 1980. He was previously director of research, development and community service for the College of Business at Saint Cloud State University in Minnesota. While at Saint Cloud State University Dr. Nappi served in various capacities ranging from Vice-President for academinc affairs, visiting professor of economics at University of Hawaii, Boise State University and University of South Dakota. He was coordinator of North Central Accreditation in 1975-76, a member of the Covernor's Task Force on Small Business in 1978-79 and on the State of Minnesota Advisory Board on small business development from 1979 until his appointment to I.S.U.

In the area of research, he has received funding of \$350,000 for 18

projects. In 1979 he was awarded \$150,000 by the United States Small Business Administration to operate a state-wide small Business Development Center and was awarded the Governor's Distinguished Service Award for his efforts. Dr. Nappi currently is credited with 25 academic publications. He received his B.S. in elementary education and M.S. in education from central Connecticut State College of New Britian Connecticut. He received his M.A. in economics and economics education in 1967 from Purdue University and a Ph. **D** in those fields from Ohio University in 1971.
