

University History

The University of Richmond can be traced back to 1830, when the Virginia Baptist Society opened a seminary for men. After adding a program for literary studies, the seminary became Richmond College in 1840. Created to follow the feminist movement of the late 19th century, Richmond College

incorporated women as non-residential students in 1898. In 1906, Richmond College, with the assistance of the Virginia Baptist General Association, made the decision to create a college for women. The goal was to create two separated colleges under the President and Board of Richmond College, but both men and women would have separate school deans, facilities, courses, buildings, and student government systems. Westhampton College was created. Women could receive a degree without having to sit in class with men. This coordinate college system was a new addition to Richmond College. Richmond College, in 1914, moved to its current location of a 350-acre plot of land west



of Richmond. This area, formerly a theme park, became the new home of the school. Also in 1914, Westhampton College opened for classes under the guidance of Dr. May Lansfield Keller, the first woman dean of a Virginia college. A few years later, both colleges were united to form the University of Richmond. The personality of the coordinate college system has remained intact. Women and men have separate student government organizations and deans, but classes are co-educational.

A pivotal point in the history of University of Richmond took place in 1969 when E. Claiborne Robins donated \$50 million to the University. This donation was the largest cash gift presented to an American University at this time. Robins challenged the University to become one of the finest small American institutions. The University of Richmond has continued to thrive and grow as a result of this generous donation.

In 2007, Dr. Edward Ayers was named University President and is still currently serving in this position.

Based on the 2012-2013 school year, the University of Richmond has 3,400 undergraduate and 961 graduate students; 44% of men and 54% of women are in attendance. Most students (81%) are out-of-state students in the 18-21 age range. In 2011, there was a 93% retention rate among freshmen and in 2012, a 30% acceptance rate into the University of Richmond. The school mascot is a Spider, colors are red and blue and the University of Richmond is home to numerous major programs including the top-ranked Robins School of Business and the first leadership school, Jepson School of Leadership Studies.







Robins School of Business Summary

The Robins School of Business at the University of Richmond is a nationally acclaimed business school. Bloomberg BusinessWeek (2012) ranked Robins #15 nationally among undergraduate business programs, #1 for undergraduate international business, #3 in academic quality, # 5 for student satisfaction and A+ in teaching quality and facilities. Students in the school of business have a unique opportunity of receiving both a liberal arts and business education while fulfilling both business and general education requirements.

Students may declare a major in Business Administration, Accounting, or Economics after completing courses in the School of Arts and Sciences (typically during sophomore year). Students declare one major, but can enhance their education with concentrations in Accounting, Economics, Finance, Marketing, Management, and International Business. Concentrations are required for Business Administration majors, but can supplement Accounting or Economics majors.


Currently there are 844 sophomores, juniors, and seniors that have officially declared majors in the business school; 259 sophomores, 295 juniors and 290 seniors spread out between Economics, Accounting and Business Administration.


