If the free registrations lead to amount in excess of \$200, the registrations will then become discounted and the \$200 split evenly among all past Western PVPs registering.

Purpose of the Proposal/Recommendation and reason(s) for its submission:

To encourage attendance of past Western PVPs and honor them for their service. The past few conferences have only been attended by two past Western PVPs, both of which had a national office in the fraternity or the Leadership Foundation.
